# Mum runs for son's recovery

When eight-year-old Kayden Gaffney's mother Stacey takes to the streets for HBF's Run for a Reason, she will be running for the Cancer Foundation, her son and the thousands of families she wants to prevent from watching their loved ones struggle with cancer.

Last year Kayden was chosen as the Cancer Council's ambassador for the inaugural event, which raises money for six WA charities including Lifeline and the Heart Foundation WA.

Diagnosed with a brain tumour five years ago, Kayden has endured rounds of treatment, scans and tests, before being given the all-clear in September.

"It is the first time in the last five years he hasn't had to have MRI scans every six to 12 weeks," Mrs Gaffney said.

Kayden, will cheer on his mum with father Andrew and sister Billie when Mrs Gaffney tackles the 14km course on May 22.
